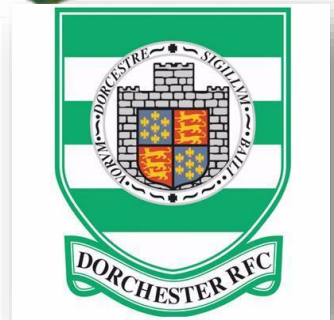


Alternatively if you have a big squad and would like a warm up game prior to the Festival then we can also arrange this.
